Cerelink® Executives Join Dot VN, Inc.’s Strategic Advisory Board

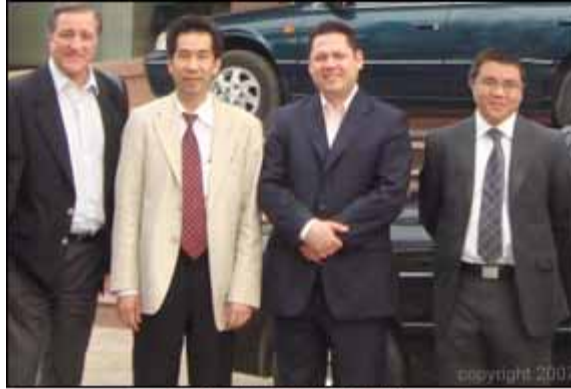
