Dr. Truc served as Deputy Minister of MPT until his retirement in 2006. Dr. Truc was also honored recently at the Sao Khue 2007 awards ceremony, held in Hanoi last month as a significant leader who has made great contributions towards the modernization of Vietnam’s telecommunications network.

Dr. Truc said, “I am very happy to join Dot VN’s Strategic Advisory Board. I look forward to contributing to Dot VN’s vision of building out Vietnam’s telecommunications and information technology infrastructure which is a key component in the socio-economic development of my country.”
